Statutory and Regulatory Disclosure to Information Utility

The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 (IBC) and the Regulations framed thereunder (as amended from time to time) mandate that Banks shall share the financial information (i.e Credit Information of all the Credit facilities - fresh/existing/renewal/enhancement and the information on the securities available and charge created in respect of the said facilities) periodically to an Information Utility.

In this regard, South Indian Bank has entered into an Agreement on 12.09.2018 with the Country's first Information Utility viz., M/s National E-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) which is registered with the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India in accordance with and is governed by IBC and the Regulations framed thereunder.

NeSL is a regulated entity whose prime function is collection, collation and dissemination of financial information. NeSL shall <u>electronically</u> collect records/ information, get authentication, maintain the information in a confidential manner and provide access of the financial information so collected and stored only to those who are permitted to have access of the information in accordance with IBC and the Regulations framed thereunder.

Upon receipt of the financial information shared by the banks periodically in compliance with IBC and the regulations framed thereunder, NeSL will send a message to entities and individuals through their email id (<u>nesliu@nesl.co.in</u>) / SMS to the mobile number registered with the Bank requesting all parties to the credit facilities either to authenticate the record of financial information submitted with NeSL or to reject the record (with valid reason for rejection to be given).
